EV2010R 06-FEB-2020 On August 3, 2019 at approximately 5:50 AM a vessel collision occurred at Fieldwood Energy's Green Canyon 65 A "Bullwinkle" manned facility. The Motor Vessel Ms. Melissa, a 170 foot support vessel contracted by Fieldwood Energy, was on approach when it collided with the platform. There were no injuries reported but both the vessel and the platform sustained damage. The vessel damaged the starboard bow area (dent and scratch) and the mast. The platform received damages to the Northwest walkway (grating, supports and wiring) and bumper (dent) located at the +10 level. Safety systems and production equipment were not damaged as a result of the incident.
