NOTICE TO LESSEES AND OPERATORS OF FEDERAL OIL AND GAS LEASES IN THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF

Partial Refund of Payments from March 1, 2022 – April 5, 2022

This Notice to Lessees and Operators (NTL) provides information to operators, lessees, and pipeline right-of-way holders regarding service fees paid to the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE) from March 1, 2022, through April 5, 2022.

The BSEE service fee amounts are specified in 30 CFR 250.125. In early 2022, BSEE undertook a rulemaking to adjust those service fees to account for inflation. On Tuesday March 1, 2022, BSEE posted the updated BSEE cost recovery fee increase adjustments for inflation in the Pay.Gov system. However, due to associated rulemaking delays, the regulatory changes had not taken effect at that time. The correct effective date for implementation of the adjusted service fees is Wednesday April 6, 2022. Therefore, BSEE will be reviewing all cost recovery fee collections received between March 1, 2022, and April 5, 2022, to process partial refunds.

Credit Card Refunds

The refund process for Credit Card payments will take place within 45-days of the signing of this NTL. An email notice will be sent to the payee from the Pay.Gov system.

ACH-Debit Refunds

The refund process for ACH-Debit (electronic checks) payments will take place within 60 days of the signing of this NTL. An email notice will be sent to payees from BseeFinanceAccountsReceivable@bsee.gov regarding the partial ACH-Debit refund. Some refunds may include more than one partial refund depending on the number of application fees paid during the period indicated above.
