Part 219: Delegation of Authority – Office of the Director

Chapter 4.4: Chief, Safety and Incident Investigations Division (SIID)

1. Purpose. This chapter provides for the redelegation of authorities by the Director, Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE), as provided for in 219 DM 1.2, to the BSEE Chief, Safety and Incident Investigations Division (SIID) to fulfill the responsibilities for those functions, programs, and activities assigned to their organization.

2. Authority.

- A. 5 U.S.C. 302, Reorganization Plan No. 3 of 1950, Section 2 (64 Stat. 1262)
- B. 209 DM 7, Secretarial authority delegated to the Assistant Secretary - Land and Minerals Management
- C. 219 DM 1, Secretarial Delegation of Authority, through the Assistant Secretary - Land and Minerals Management, to the Director, Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement
- D. 119 DM 4, Safety and Environmental Enforcement

3. Policy. Subject to the limitations in 209 DM 7, 219 DM 1, and this chapter, the Chief, SIID is delegated the program and administrative authority of the Director, BSEE, to fulfill the functions and responsibilities identified in 119 DM 4.4.

4. Redlegation of General Authorities. Except where redelegation is prohibited by statute, Executive Order, or limitations established by other competent authority, including the limitations in this chapter, general program authorities may be redelegated. All redelegations of authority must be in writing, and in accordance with BSEEM 200.1, Redelegations.

Officials who delegate their authority do not divest themselves of the power to exercise that authority, nor does the redelegation relieve them of the responsibility for action taken in accordance with the redelegation.

5. Acting Officials. Unless otherwise stated in a redelegation, Acting Officials have the full authority of those whose duties they are performing. No special redelegations of authority need be made to anyone serving in an Acting capacity.
