(Curtailed production means well production that is metered for MMS royalties, sales, and other disbursements on your facility that is shut in either partially or totally because of the spill associated with the Horizon incident. This includes un-metered production boarding from other facilities and/or shut-in subsea wells that flow to and are metered on your facility. If production is metered onshore, include that shut-in production in your report.)

This information should be reported immediately. This does not need to be a daily report. Please provide any information regarding effects to personnel and the facility in the "Comment" section. This information should be emailed to MMS.GOM.ICC@MMS.GOV.
