

AGREEMENT BETWEEN

DIVISION OF GEOLOGICAL AND GEOPHYSICAL SURVEYS


Purpose: This agreement is for the purpose of transferring to the State of Alaska nonproprietary Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) well samples.

Objectives and Conditions:


The overall objective of the agreement is to make available to interested parties well samples for geological study. Since the State of Alaska has an established well-sample facility at Eagle River, Alaska, it is logical to store all well samples at a single facility for ease of inspection by the public. Upon signing this agreement, the Minerals Management Service agrees to transfer to the State of Alaska approximately 86 cubic feet of nonproprietary well samples and core chips. From time-to-time as other samples become available, other sample transfers will be made. The 86 cubic feet of samples currently available represents 10 years of OCS drilling activity, so expected volume for future transfer is relatively small.

Upon signing this agreement, the State of Alaska agrees to accept the well samples and core chips and to store the samples and make them available for public inspection.
