NOTICE TO LESSEES AND OPERATORS OF FEDERAL OIL, GAS, AND SULPHUR LEASES IN THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF, GULF OF MEXICO OCS REGION

Removing Underwater Casing Stubs

This Notice to Lessees and Operators (NTL) supersedes the Letter to Lessees and Operators, dated June 27, 1990, on this subject. It updates regulatory citations and includes a statement on the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995.

According to 30 CFR 250.703, you may temporarily abandon a well with an underwater casing stub. If, at a future date, you decide or the Gulf of Mexico OCS Region (GOMR) requires you to permanently abandon such a well (see requirements at 30 CFR 250.702), you are advised that you must submit a request (according to 30 CFR 250.913) to the GOMR Regional Supervisor, Field Operations (MS 5200) and receive his approval before you may conduct the work.

You are further advised that whenever you use explosives to remove an underwater casing stub, the charge should not exceed 50 pounds unless absolutely necessary.
