NOTICE TO LESSEES AND OPERATORS OF FEDERAL OIL, GAS, AND SULPHUR LEASES IN THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF, GULF OF MEXICO OCS REGION

Implementation of Consistent Biological Stipulation Measures in the Central and Western Gulf of Mexico

This notice supersedes Notice to Lessees and Operators No. 89-01, effective August 1, 1989, and makes minor technical amendments and includes a statement regarding the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995.

Introduction and Background

Oil and gas exploration and development activities in the vicinity of sensitive biological habitats associated with topographic features on the Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) (e.g., coral reefs) may cause deleterious impacts to those habitats in several ways, including toxic and smothering effects from drilling and production effluent, and mechanical damage from rig, platform and anchor emplacement. A stipulation to protect such habitats has been made a part of appropriate OCS oil and gas leases since 1973. The Topographic Features Stipulation of the Central and Western Gulf of Mexico Planning Area has been revised slightly from time to time to incorporate findings of research and monitoring. Beginning with Lease Sales 110 (Central Gulf) and 112 (Western Gulf) held in 1987, however, the provisions of this stipulation constituted a more substantial revision.

Purpose and Scope

1. In order to provide necessary and sufficient protection for the sensitive biological habitats of the topographic features of the Central and Western Gulf Planning Areas, it is necessary to require measures based on the latest and best available scientific information. The leases resulting from Sales 110, 112, and all subsequent sales contain the revised stipulation. Operators of leases on affected blocks issued prior to 1987 now have two options. You may elect to conduct your operations in conformance with this latest version of the stipulation, or you may elect to comply with the stipulation in your lease document.

2. Attachment 1 lists the blocks affected by the Topographic Features Stipulation. Attachment 2 provides the text of the stipulation as it is currently applied and lists the topographic features.

Implementation

1. Beginning August 1, 1989, operators of leases in the Central and Western Gulf of Mexico Planning Areas issued prior to 1987 on blocks listed in Attachment 1 may comply with either the provisions of Attachment 2 of this notice or with the provisions of the biological topographic features stipulation contained in their lease.

2. Plans of Exploration and Development Operations Coordination Documents submitted for leases issued prior to 1987 on blocks listed in Attachment 1 must explicitly declare which version of the Topographic Features Stipulation will be followed.

3. This notice affects only the stipulation in the lease designed to protect biological resources on the topographic features (Topographic Features Stipulation) in the Central and Western Gulf of Mexico Planning Areas. All other stipulations and lease provisions remain unchanged.

Exception

The provisions of this notice must not be construed to modify or cancel any biological monitoring plan that has been approved by the Gulf of Mexico OCS Region.

Paperwork Reduction Act Statement

The information collection provisions of this notice are intended to provide clarification, description, or interpretation of requirements contained in lease stipulations and 30 CFR 250, Subpart B. The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has approved the information collection requirements for Subpart B and has assigned OMB Control Number 1010-0049. This notice does not impose additional information collection requirements subject to the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995.

ATTACHMENT 2

The Topographic Features Stipulation

(a) No activity including structures, drilling rigs, pipelines, or anchoring will be allowed within the listed isobath ("No Activity Zone") of the banks as listed above.

(b) Operations within the area shown as "1,000 Meter Zone" will be restricted by shunting all drill cuttings and drilling fluids to the bottom through a downpipe that terminates an appropriate distance, but no more than ten meters, from the bottom.

(c) Operations within the area shown as "1 Mile Zone" will be restricted by shunting all drill cuttings and drilling fluids to the bottom through a downpipe that terminates an appropriate distance, but no more than ten meters, from the bottom. (Where there is a "1 Mile Zone" designated, the 1,000 Meter Zone in paragraph (b) is not designated.)

(d) Operations within the area shown as "3 Mile Zone" will be restricted by shunting all drill cuttings and drilling fluids from development operations to the bottom through a downpipe that terminates an appropriate distance, but no more than ten meters, from the bottom.
