Outage of Fees for Services due to Fiscal Year-end Closeout

Due to fiscal year-end closeout, the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE) will disable the Fees for Services Refund Request Form from 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, Friday, September 9, 2016, to 9:00 a.m. Monday, October 3, 2016.

In addition, BSEE will disable Pay.Gov forms and payment options for eWell, online ordering and public information systems from 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, Friday, September 23, 2016, to 9:00 a.m. Monday, October 3, 2016. September 23rd is the final day for accepting payments.
