To keep you informed about the effect of Hurricane Opal on offshore energy production in the Gulf of Mexico, the Minerals Management Service will provide status reports as information becomes available.

\*\*Oil Production Shut-In: 817,528 barrels

Evacuations: 824 platforms and 116 rigs.

OPERATORS ARE BEGINNING THE RESUMPTION OF PRODUCTION. NO FIGURES AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME.

- \* Daily Gas Production in the Gulf is about 13 billion cubic feet
- \*\* Daily Oil Production in the Gulf is about 800,000 barrels

NOTE: An estimated 60 structures were exposed to hurricane force winds. No damage reports have been received, but a request has been made to operators that they file damage reports with our Gulf of Mexico Region as soon as possible. MMS expects to fly a helicopter over the area today in an effort to make a preliminary damage determination.

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
