17. INVESTIGATION FINDINGS:

On July 12, 2012, the Injured Person (IP) was carrying a fire extinguisher down a flight of stairs. The IP was using the three point method when walking down the stairs. This means that the IP had one hand on the hand rail while the other hand was carrying the fire extinguisher. When reaching the bottom of the stairs, the IP took a step thinking that the he had one more stair to clear. This resulted in the IP severely twisting his ankle at the bottom of the stairs. IP reported to the medic and was flown into a medical facility onshore, he had x-rays taken and the physician determined the fibula in the left leg was broken. The IP underwent surgery to repair the broken bone and will be on restricted duty for four weeks. A pre-job safety meeting occurred prior to the work being performed. All the hazards were addressed in the JSA. The injured person had used all safety precautions including using the three point method when walking down the stairs.

The probable cause of the accident was determined to be an accidental slip/trip. A pre-job safety meeting occurred prior to the work being performed. All the hazards were addressed in the JSA. The injured person had used all safety precautions including using the three point method when walking down the stairs.
