Rig crew was laying down 3.5 inch drill pipe when one of the 4 point shackle's nut came off due to improper size of cotter pin causing a joint of pipe to fall in the v-door striking two rig personnel. Floor Man was struck on the left shoulder and a Roustabout was struck on the left arm. Both personnel were attended by the onsite Medic, and then transported ashore by boat for further evaluation and treatment

Operator/Contractor failed to properly rig up the single joint elevators which caused an occurrence of a joint of drill pipe and the single joint elevators to fall from v-door to the catwalk striking two rig personnel.

Operator/Contractor failed to utilize the proper sized cotter pin while rigging up the single joint elevators.

Operator/Contractor failed to develop or utilize a checklist for rigging up the single joint elevators to ensure the proper sized shackle(s), cotter pin(s), and slings were utilized prior to the job task.

Operator/Contractor failed to ensure all rigging was inspected by the Driller or Tool Pusher prior to beginning the job task.

Prior to the job task, the Job Safety Analysis (JSA) developed by the drill crew failed to incorporate the crane crew personnel in the JSA for laying down drill pipe.

#### 18. LIST THE PROBABLE CAUSE(S) OF ACCIDENT:

Failure to properly rig up the single joint elevators which caused an occurrence of a joint of drill pipe and the single joint elevators to fall from v-door to the catwalk striking two rig personnel.

Failure to utilize the proper size cotter pin while rigging up the single joint elevators.

Failure to develop or utilize a checklist for rigging up the single joint elevators to ensure the proper size shackle(s), cotter pin(s), and slings were utilized prior to the job task.

Failure to ensure all rigging was inspected by the Driller or Tool Pusher prior to beginning the job task.

Prior to the job task, the Job Safety Analysis (JSA) developed by the drill crew failed to incorporate the crane crew personnel in the JSA for laying down drill pipe.

### 19. LIST THE CONTRIBUTING CAUSE(S) OF ACCIDENT:

Failure of the Driller or Tool Pusher to inspect the rigging prior to the job task beginning.
