(W)Warning: A warning INC is issued if the violation is not considered to be severe or threatening. The violation must be corrected within a reasonable amount of time as specified on the INC.

(C)Component Shut-in: A component shut-in INC is issued when a violation is considered severe or threatening. The operator must shut-in the component or piece of equipment that is in violation. The violation must be corrected before the operator is allowed to continue the activity in question.
